House Bill 1088 (Delegate McKee)
Judiciary

Courts - Victims of Crime - Immunity From Civil Liability

This bill prohibits a person engaged in a violent criminal activity from maintaining a civil action for damages against the victim of the criminal conduct. The bill also outlines the responsibilities of the court regarding the verification, termination, or postponement of the civil action.
