Senate Bill 168 (Senator Sfikas) Judicial Proceedings

## Volunteer Fire Companies, Rescue Squads, and Emergency Medical Services Units - Command and Supervisory Responsibilities

This bill prohibits a member of a volunteer fire company, rescue squad, or emergency medical services unit from supervising a person who is employed by a State, county, or municipal fire department, rescue squad, or emergency medical services unit on an "integrated response" unless the volunteer meets certain local criteria for supervisory and command personnel. Likewise, a volunteer may not command operations on an integrated response. Integrated response means those instances when both volunteer and career units respond to an emergency.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** None. Prohibiting certain volunteer fire, rescue, and medical services personnel from supervising or commanding local employees would not directly affect local government finances.

**Small Business Effect:** None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.
