## **Lobbyists Reporting Requirements - Special Events - Delegations of the General Assembly**

This bill requires lobbyists to report functions or special events to the State Ethics Commission if all the members of a county or regional delegation of the General Assembly are invited. Current law provides that lobbyists must report these functions only if all members of the General Assembly, either house, or a standing committee are invited.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill would not directly affect State finances.

Local Effect: None.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal impact on the administrative requirements of small lobbying businesses due to the reporting requirement of the bill. The finances of such small businesses would not be materially affected.
