## **Education - Student Suspension and Expulsion**

This departmental bill enables a county superintendent of schools to deny attendance to a student currently expelled from an out-of-state school system. County superintendents already have the authority to deny attendance for students expelled from schools within the State.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1997.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Denying admission to public schools for certain out-of-state students would not affect local government finances.

**Small Business Effect:** The Department of Education has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small businesses (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment.
