Senate Bill 398 (Chairman, Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee)
(Departmental - Education)
Economic and Environmental Affairs

Education - Student Suspension and Expulsion

This departmental bill enables a county superintendent of schools to deny attendance to a student currently expelled from an out-of-state school system. County superintendents already have the authority to deny attendance for students expelled from schools within the State.

This bill takes effect July 1, 1997.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Denying admission to public schools for certain out-of-state students would not affect local government finances.

Small Business Effect: The Department of Education has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small businesses (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment.
