**Election Laws - Voters - Accompaniment in Voting Booth or Machine**

---

This enrolled bill increases the maximum age, from five to ten, at which a child may accompany an adult into a voting booth or machine without obtaining an affidavit indicating that the voter needs the child's assistance to vote.

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** None. Increasing the maximum age limit would not directly affect county finances.
