**Kent County - Alcoholic Beverages (Expungement)**

This enrolled bill requires the Kent County Board of License Commissioners to expunge past violations of alcoholic beverages laws and regulations from a licensee's record after seven years from the date the violation occurred.

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** None. The Board of License Commissioners could expunge past violations from licensees' records with existing resources.

**Small Business Effect:** Minimal. To the extent that expungement allows for opportunities to enhance their operations, small businesses could be affected.
