House Bill 479 (Delegate McKee) Economic Matters

Commercial Law - Abandoned Property - Required Notice

This bill requires that before a property (e.g., bank account) is considered abandoned by a holding bank, financial institution, or business association, the depositor must be issued a notice by certified mail, return receipt requested. Under current law, the depositor is issued a notice by first class mail.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill does not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: Minimal increase in postage expenses for those small businesses that hold property and must notify the owner in the case of abandoned property.
