Senate Bill 329 (Senator Collins) (Baltimore County Sheriff) Judicial Proceedings

Baltimore County - Sheriff - Salary

This bill increases the maximum salary of the Baltimore County Sheriff from \$60,000 to \$70,000. The increase does not take effect until the next term of office.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Baltimore County expenditures would increase by \$5,630 in FY 1999, and by \$11,260 annually thereafter.

Small Business Effect: None. The bill would not directly affect small businesses.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: Currently, the Baltimore County Sheriff receives a salary of \$60,000 annually, excluding fringe benefits. Beginning in calendar 1999, it is assumed that the salary will be increased to \$70,000 annually. As a result, expenditures would increase by \$5,630 in fiscal 1999. This estimate reflects the salary increase for six months and fringe benefits at 12.60% of the salary. Beginning in fiscal 2000, expenditures would increase by \$11,260 annually, reflecting a full-year's salary and fringe benefits.
