AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1151

(Bill As Printed For Third Reading)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "County Boards of Education" and substitute "Education - Noncertificated Employees"; strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 3 down through "education." in line 8 and substitute "requiring the State Board of Education to adopt regulations that prohibit the hiring, by county boards of education, of noncertificated employees who have been convicted of certain crimes; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the hiring of noncertificated employees by county boards of education."; in line 9, strike "repealing and reenacting, with amendments," and substitute "adding to"; and in line 11, strike "6-201" and substitute "6-113".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 1 through line 34 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

6-113.

THE STATE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT WILL PROHIBIT A COUNTY BOARD FROM HIRING, AS A NONCERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE, ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A CRIME INVOLVING:

(1) UNLAWFUL MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION, OR DISPENSING OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 286, § 286C, § 286D, § 287(D), § 288, § 289, § 290, OR § 301A OF THE CODE;

(2) AN OFFENSE UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 464B OF THE CODE;

(3) CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27, § 35C(A)(2)(II) AND

(Over)

(6) OF THE CODE, OR AN OFFENSE UNDER THE LAWS OF ANOTHER STATE THAT WOULD CONSTITUTE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27, § 35C(A)(2)(II) AND (6) OF THE CODE IF COMMITTED IN THIS STATE; OR

(4) A CRIME OF VIOLENCE AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 27, § 643B OF THE CODE, OR AN OFFENSE UNDER THE LAWS OF ANOTHER STATE THAT WOULD BE A VIOLATION OF ARTICLE 27, § 643B OF THE CODE IF COMMITTED IN THIS STATE.”.
