AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1152

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Assistance Program" and substitute "Programs"; in line 10, after "extent;" insert "requiring that each State-funded school construction project shall require the contractor to have a certain apprenticeship program; requiring that the contractor hire apprentices at a certain ratio to the number of journeypersons; defining certain terms;"; in line 11, after "Program" insert "and apprenticeship programs for school construction projects"; and after line 11, insert:

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 19, insert:

"Article - Education

5-309.

(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "APPROVED AND REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM" MEANS A PROGRAM THAT IS:

(I) REGISTERED IN THIS STATE; AND

(Over)

(II) APPROVED BY THE APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING COUNCIL  
UNDER § 11-403 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.

(3) "CONSTRUCTION" MEANS:

(I) BUILDING;

(II) RECONSTRUCTING;

(III) IMPROVING;

(IV) ENLARGING;

(V) PAINTING OR DECORATING;

(VI) ALTERING;

(VII) MAINTAINING; OR

(VIII) REPAIRING.

(B) A CONTRACT FOR A SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT THAT IS FUNDED  
IN WHOLE OR IN ANY PART BY STATE FUNDS SHALL REQUIRE THE CONTRACTOR  
TO:

(1) HAVE IN PLACE AN APPROVED AND REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP  
PROGRAM; AND

(2) HIRE STATE-REGISTERED APPRENTICES AT A RATIO OF ONE  
APPRENTICE FOR EVERY THREE JOURNEYPERSONS.'".
