(III) IMPROVING;
(IV) ENLARGING;
(V) PAINTING OR DECORATING;
(VI) ALTERING;
(VII) MAINTAINING; OR

(VIII) REPAIRING.

- (B) A CONTRACT FOR A SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECT THAT IS FUNDED IN WHOLE OR IN ANY PART BY STATE FUNDS SHALL REQUIRE THE CONTRACTOR TO:
- (1) HAVE IN PLACE AN APPROVED AND REGISTERED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM; AND
- (2) HIRE STATE-REGISTERED APPRENTICES AT A RATIO OF ONE APPRENTICE FOR EVERY THREE JOURNEYPERSONS.".
