AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 712, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 5, after “mammal”“ insert “; requiring the Department of Natural Resources to report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date on certain aspects of the coyote population in the State; and generally relating to the hunting and trapping of coyotes”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In the Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0712/604814/1), in line 2 of Amendment No. 2, strike “6” and substitute “5”; and in the same line, strike “September 30, 2001” and substitute “September 30, 2000”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3 of the bill, after line 20, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Natural Resources shall report to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2000, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the status and trends of the coyote population in the State, including the significance of the changing role of the coyote population in the State’s natural environment and any other impact of the coyote population on the State’s natural environment.”;

and in line 21, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
