## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 203

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike beginning with "including" in line 3 down through "charge" in line 5 and substitute "requiring the Comptroller to conduct a study to determine how shipping and handling charges on mail-order purchases are taxed by other states and how the charges are stated in relation to the taxable price by direct marketers; requiring the Comptroller to report on the results of the study to certain committees of the General Assembly; and generally relating to a study on shipping and handling charges on mail-order purchases"; strike in their entirety lines 6 through 10, inclusive; and in line 12, strike "the Laws of Maryland read as follows".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

Strike in their entirety lines 13 through 22, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(a) The Office of the Comptroller shall conduct a study of the sales and use taxation of shipping and handling charges on mail-order purchases which shall include:
- (1) a survey of other states to determine the treatment of shipping and handling charges on mail-order purchases for purposes of sales and use taxation; and
- (2) a survey of the current treatment of shipping and handling charges by direct marketers.
- (b) The Comptroller shall complete and report the results of the study to the House Committee on Ways and Means and the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee by October 15, 1998.".
