AMENDMENTS TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

(First Reading File Joint Resolution)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Miller” and substitute “Miller, and Middleton”; in line 27, strike “now therefore, be it” and substitute “and”; and after line 27 insert:

“WHEREAS, In December 1997, the Ottawa Treaty, The Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Land Mines and Their Destruction was signed by 125 nations, the United States not among them; now, therefore, be it”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 6, insert:

“RESOLVED, That the President of the United States and the Congress of the United States are respectfully urged to resist any efforts to cancel or weaken the current moratorium on the United States’ use of anti-personnel land mines; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the President of the United States and the Congress of the United States are respectfully urged to take the steps necessary to codify the President’s goals to end the United States’ use of all anti-personnel land mines by the year 2006, thereby establishing a date certain for the United States to sign the Ottawa Treaty; and be it further”.
