AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 14

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after the semicolon insert “requiring the Chief Judge of the District Court to establish a certain schedule of prepaid fines for persons charged by citation; allowing persons who do not wish to contest guilt to prepay a fine under certain circumstances; prohibiting a law enforcement officer from deviating from a certain schedule of prepaid fines under certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 10, strike “§§ 12-501 and 12-502” and substitute “§ 12-501”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, after line 29, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Chief Judge of the District Court shall establish a fine or penalty deposit schedule for persons charged by citation under Article 27, § 594B-2 of the Annotated Code. A person charged by citation under Article 27, § 594B-2 may prepay the fine in the amount established in the schedule if the person does not care to contest guilt in the case. A law enforcement officer may not deviate from the schedule established under this section if the officer charges an individual by citation under Article 27, § 594B-2.”;

and in line 30, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
