AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 284

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after the first “programs” insert “if certain regulations have been adopted; requiring the Department to report to certain committees of the General Assembly at a certain time; providing for the termination of this Act”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 21, after “TITLE” insert “IF REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN ADOPTED FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF RESIDENT PROPERTY ENTRUSTED TO THE ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM PURSUANT TO § 19-1805(B)(2)(IV) OF THIS TITLE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 13, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene shall report to the House Environmental Matters Committee and the Senate Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee, on or before January 1, 1999, on any regulations adopted or proposed by the Department for the management of property of residents of assisted living facilities.”;

in line 14, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”; and in line 15, after “1998.” insert “It shall remain in effect for a period of 2 years and, at the end of September 30, 2000, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force or effect.”.
