## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1364 (First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute "<u>Cosmetology - Prohibited</u> <u>Acts</u>"; strike beginning with the first "of" in line 4 down through "salons;" in line 14; strike beginning with "establishing" in line 16 down through "Cosmetologists" in line 18 and substitute "<u>authorizing an inspector to take certain actions when the inspector has reasonable cause to believe</u> that the person is using or possesses methyl methacrylate liquid monomer in a beauty salon in the State; and generally relating to a prohibition of the use or possession of methyl methacrylate liquid <u>monomer</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 19 through 30, inclusive.

On page 2, in line 2, strike "5-304(c), 5-310(e), 5-311.1, 5-520(e), 5-520.1, 5-604(c), and".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 through 9, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 8 on page 2 through line 18 on page 12, inclusive.

On pages 12 and 13, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 22 on page 12 through line 6 on page 13, inclusive, and substitute:

"(B) TO DETERMINE BY CHEMICAL TESTING WHETHER A PERSON IS IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, AN INSPECTOR MAY TAKE A SAMPLE OF ANY PRODUCT IN A BEAUTY SALON THAT THE INSPECTOR HAS REASONABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE IS METHYL METHACRYLATE LIQUID MONOMER (MMA).".
