AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 185

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Krysiak” and substitute “Krysiak, Bobo, Pendergrass, Turner, Morgan, Mohorovic, Montague, McHale, DeCarlo, Dewberry, Getty, Fulton, Marriott, Boston, Opara, Kirk, C. Mitchell, Watson, Branch, C. Davis, Harrison, Malone, D. Murphy, Bissett, Clagett, Crumlin, B. Hughes, Patterson, Proctor, Hutchins, Slade, Exum, Rzepkowski, M. Burns, Hubbard, Dembrow, Mandel, Gordon, Genn, Barve, Snodgrass, Conway, Pitkin, Faulkner, Brinkley, and Benson”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 25, strike “AND”; and in line 28, after “IMPAIRED” insert “; AND”

(4) SHALL BE OBTAINED, WHENEVER POSSIBLE, WITHOUT MODIFICATION FOR COMPATIBILITY WITH SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE FOR NONVISUAL ACCESS”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 4, inclusive, and substitute:

“(I) THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY IS NOT AVAILABLE WITH NONVISUAL ACCESS BECAUSE THE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY ARE VISUAL AND NONVISUAL EQUIVALENCE CANNOT BE DEVELOPED; OR

(II) THE COST OF MODIFYING THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY TO SUPPORT NONVISUAL ACCESS WOULD INCREASE THE COST OF THE PROCUREMENT BY MORE THAN 5 PERCENT.”.
