SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in addition to the amount authorized under § 21-315(c) of the State Personnel and Pensions Article, for [fiscal year 1998] FISCAL YEAR 1999 the Board of Trustees may pay up to [0.30%] 0.60% of the payroll of the members to the expense funds to provide for the administration and operation of each system in accordance with § 21-315(d) of the State Personnel and Pensions Article. If additional moneys authorized under this

section are not paid in [fiscal year 1998] FISCAL YEAR 1999, the Board of Trustees may pay the amount of additional moneys authorized but not paid, in [fiscal year 1999 or] FISCAL YEAR 2000 OR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1993. It shall remain effective for a period of [7] 8 years and, at the end of June 30, [2000] 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect."
