# AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 686 (Bill As Printed for Third Reading)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 8, strike "<u>in a certain</u>" and substitute "<u>as a pilot project in one</u>"; in line 11, after the semicolon insert "<u>requiring the Secretary to establish a certain demonstration project in the</u> <u>Glen Burnie Multi-Service Center</u>;".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 15, in line 15, strike the colon; in line 16, strike "(1)"; in line 17, strike "<u>Anne</u> <u>Arundel County</u>" and substitute "<u>one jurisdiction</u>"; strike in their entirety lines 18 through 22, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 17, after line 4, insert:

"SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October 1, 1998, the Secretary of Human Resources shall establish with the Secretary of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation and the Superintendent of Education a demonstration project in the Glen Burnie Multi-Service Center to integrate the physical locations, staff, and resources of the Anne Arundel County Department of Social Services Job Center, the Job Service, the Unemployment Insurance Office, and the Division of Rehabilitation, to improve the efficiency of customer service and reduce duplication of services. The Secretary of Human Resources shall report to the Joint Committee on Welfare Reform, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on or before December 1, 1998 on the progress of the demonstration project.";

and in line 5, strike "8." and substitute "9.".
