AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 197, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 2, strike “and Reimbursement” and substitute “Reimbursement, and Terms of Office of Members”; in line 5, before “and” insert “prohibiting a member from serving more than a certain number of full terms of office;”; in line 6, strike “and reimbursement for” and substitute “reimbursement, and terms of office of”; and in line 15, after “Section” insert “9-105(c) and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the bill, after line 23, insert:

“9-105.

(c) (1) The term of a member is 4 years.

(2) The terms of members are staggered as required by the terms provided for members of the Commission on October 1, 1984.

(3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

(5) A MEMBER MAY NOT SERVE FOR MORE THAN TWO FULL TERMS.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

In the Finance Committee Amendments (SB0197/057459/1), in line 4 of Amendment No. 2, after “AMOUNT” insert “EQUAL TO”; in line 5, strike “UP TO \$3,000” and substitute “\$100 PER MEETING, UP TO \$1,500”; and in line 7, strike “UP TO \$4,000” and substitute “\$150 PER MEETING, UP TO \$2,250”.
