## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 657

(Third Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with "<u>altering</u>" in line 14 down through "<u>period</u>;" in line 15; in line 16, strike "<u>a certain exception</u>" and substitute "<u>certain exceptions</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 19 through 23, inclusive.

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 14 on page 2 through line 2 on page 3, inclusive.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 28, strike "at least".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, in line 27, after "section" insert "and Section 6 of this Act"; strike beginning with "As" in line 31 down through "contract" in line 34, and substitute "Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, § 5-307(d) of the Education Article as enacted by this Act shall remain in effect and shall not terminate without further action by the General Assembly"; and in line 35, after "That" insert:

"except as provided in Section 5(b) of this Act, the provisions of this Act shall be null and void if any party to the Memorandum of Understanding in the case of Vaughns, et al. v. Board of Education of Prince George's County, et al. declares the Memorandum of Understanding null and void or if the District Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Maryland declares the Memorandum of Understanding null and void.

SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That".
