AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 667

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 10, before “defining” insert “prohibiting a carrier from terminating, limiting, or impairing the contract or employment of a provider with the carrier on the basis that the provider refused to agree to an assignment, transfer, or subcontracting of the contract under certain circumstances;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 22, after “(B)” insert “(1)”; and after line 26, insert:

“(2) A CARRIER MAY NOT TERMINATE, LIMIT, OR OTHERWISE IMPAIR THE CONTRACT OR EMPLOYMENT OF A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER WITH THE CARRIER ON THE BASIS THAT THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER REFUSED TO AGREE TO AN ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER, OR SUBCONTRACT OF ALL OR PART OF THE HEALTH CARE PROVIDER’S CONTRACT.”.
