AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 838

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after “persons;” insert “requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to expunge certain records pertaining to probation before judgment;”; and in line 13, after “16-117” insert “and 16-117.1(d)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 4, strike “this article” and substitute “THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 26, insert:

“16-117.1.

(d) The Administration shall expunge from its driver record data base the driving record of an individual OR A PROBATION BEFORE JUDGMENT DISPOSITION OF AN INDIVIDUAL:

(1) Who has not been convicted of a moving violation or criminal offense involving a motor vehicle for the preceding 3 years;

(2) Who has not been convicted of, or been granted probation before judgment for:

(i) A violation of § 20-102 of this article;

(ii) A violation of § 21-902 of this article; or

(iii) A moving violation identical or substantially similar to § 20-102 or

(Over)

§ 21-902 of this article; and

(3) Whose license or privilege to drive never has been suspended or revoked.”.
