AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 178, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the bill, in line 6, after "purposes;" insert "establishing a Poultry Litter Transportation Pilot Project;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 through 3 of the Economic and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0178/714413/15), in Amendment No. 2, strike beginning with "8-704.2." in line 5 on page 1 through "OCCURS." in line 12 on page 3 and substitute:

"<u>8-704.2.</u>

- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PILOT PROJECT" MEANS THE POULTRY LITTER TRANSPORTATION PILOT PROJECT.
 - (B) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT:
- (1) FOR A 3-YEAR PERIOD THE STATE SHALL FACILITATE THE PROMPT TRANSPORTATION OF POULTRY LITTER FROM FARMS IN AREAS OF THE STATE THAT EXPERIENCE PHOSPHOROUS OVERENRICHMENT;
- (2) THE PILOT PROJECT SHALL ENCOURAGE VOLUNTARY
 PARTICIPATION TO ACHIEVE THE REMOVAL OF POULTRY LITTER PRODUCED BY 20%
 OF THE POULTRY IN THE FOUR LOWER EASTERN SHORE COUNTIES IN MARYLAND;
 AND
- (3) THE PILOT PROJECT SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE POULTRY LITTER MATCHING SERVICE SET FORTH IN § 8-704.1 OF THIS

SUBTITLE.

- (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PILOT PROJECT IS TO ESTABLISH A COST SHARE PROGRAM TO ASSIST IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF POULTRY LITTER FROM FARMS OVER A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS:
- (1) TO BE USED IN AREAS WITH SOIL HOLDING CAPACITY FOR PHOSPHOROUS; OR
 - (2) TO BE USED IN WAYS OTHER THAN LAND APPLICATION.
- (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS AUTHORIZING THE DISBURSEMENT OF COST SHARE FUNDS FROM THIS PROGRAM.
- (E) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE ASSISTANCE NECESSARY TO ENSURE THAT POULTRY LITTER IS TESTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH DEPARTMENTAL PROCEDURES BEFORE TRANSPORTATION OF THE LITTER OCCURS.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 7 of the Committee Amendments, in line 3 of Amendment No. 11, strike "<u>4</u>" and "<u>2002</u>" and substitute "<u>3</u>" and "<u>2001</u>", respectively.
