## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 2, in line 9, after "HOUSE" insert "<u>ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE HOUSE SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE OR ANOTHER MEMBER OF THAT COMMITTEE DESIGNATED BY THE CHAIRMAN</u>"; after line 13, insert:

"(4) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES;";

after line 26, insert:

## "(12) ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF SOCIAL SERVICE DIRECTORS;";

and in lines 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31, strike "(4)", "(5)", "(6)", "(7)", "(8)", "(9)", "(10)", "(11)", "(12)", "(13)", "(14)", and "(15)", respectively, and substitute "(5)", "(6)", "(7)", "(8)", "(9)", "(10)", "(11)", "(13)", "(14)", "(15)", "(16)", and "(17)", respectively.

On page 3, in lines 1, 2, and 3, strike "(16)", "(17)", and "(18)", respectively, and substitute "(18)", "(19)", and "(20)", respectively.

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 19, strike "AND"; and in line 21, after "PROGRAMS" insert ", <u>BOTH</u> SHORT-TERM AND LONG-TERM;
