AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 659

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, strike “increasing” and substitute “altering”; strike beginning with “for” in line 4 down through “violation” in line 5 and substitute “under certain circumstances for certain violations”; in line 6, after “injury” insert “or death”; strike beginning with “increasing” in line 8 down through “circumstances;” in line 12; in line 13, after “in” insert “bodily injury or”; in the same line, after “death;” insert “clarifying language;”; in line 20, strike “, 20-104(d),”; and strike in their entirety lines 23 through 27, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
Article - Transportation  
Section 20-104(d)  
Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1992 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 9 and 12, in each instance, strike the brackets; in lines 9 and 12, in each instance, strike “any” and substitute “ANOTHER”; strike in their entirety lines 14 through 22, inclusive; in line 27, strike “OR § 20-102.1”; in line 32, in each instance, strike the bracket; in the same line, strike “ACCIDENT” ; and in line 33, strike the closing bracket.

On page 3, in line 3, after the closing bracket insert “, IF THE ACCIDENT RESULTED IN BODILY INJURY TO ANOTHER PERSON,”; in line 4, strike “3 years” and substitute “1 YEAR”; in line 5, strike “§ 20-102.1” and substitute “§ 20-102”; in line 6, strike “ACCIDENT” and substitute “ACCIDENTS”; in the same line, after “IN” insert “BODILY INJURY OR”; in line 7, after “TO” insert “, IF THE ACCIDENT RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON,”; and in line 12, strike “§ 20-102.1” and substitute “§ 20-102”.
