AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 869

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “altering” in line 7 down through “law;” in line 9 and substitute “requiring the Insurance Commissioner to submit a certain report by a certain date;”; and in line 13, strike “, 23-405(a), and 23-505.2” and substitute “and 23-405(a)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 10 through 15, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, after line 15, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before January 15, 1999, the Insurance Commissioner shall report, subject to § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly on the advisability of placing a cap or otherwise limiting, upon cancellation of an insurance contract, the application of any expense constant, administrative fee, or other non-refundable charge imposed in connection with that contract.”;

and in line 16, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
