AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 2, strike "Property Tax Exemption" and substitute "<u>Baltimore City - Tax Credit</u>"; in line 3, strike "providing for an exemption from" and substitute "<u>authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City to grant a property tax credit against the</u>"; in line 6, strike "adding to" and substitute "<u>repealing and reenacting, with amendments,</u>"; and in line 8, strike "7-241" and substitute "<u>9-304(b)</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

In line 14, strike "7-241." and substitute "9-304."; strike line 15 in its entirety and substitute:

"(b) The Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City may grant, by law, a property tax credit under this section against the county property tax imposed on:

(1) real property that is leased, occupied, and used only by the Baltimore Association for Retarded Citizens, Incorporated; AND

(2) PROPERTY THAT IS:";

in lines 16, 17, and 18, strike "(1)", "(2)", and "(3)", respectively, and substitute "(I)", "(III)", and "(III)", respectively; and in line 20, strike "July 1" and substitute "June 1".
