- 16 (a) The maximum amount payable from the Fund, exclusive of interest and 17 costs, for claims filed under this subtitle arising from one accident is:
- 18 (1) [\$20,000] \$30,000 on account of injury to or death of one individual;
- 19 subject to the limit specified in item (1) of this subsection, [\$40,000] (2) 20 \$60,000 on account of injury to or death of more than one individual; and
- 21 (3) [\$10,000] \$15,000 for damages to property.
