	WHEREAS, The right to free speech is a fundamental right guaranteed to the citizens of this State by both the United States Constitution and the Maryland Declaration of Rights; and
23 24	WHEREAS, The right of political expression is one of the most basic rights of free speech; and

WHEREAS, The restriction by homeowners associations, condominiums, and 26 cooperative housing corporations, of the political speech of its residents is contrary to

27 the principles of free speech; now, therefore,
