A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Child Support Guidelines - Determination of Child Support Obligation -**
3 **Private Instruction or Tutoring**

4 FOR the purpose of including certain expenses for private instruction or tutoring in
5 the expenses incurred on behalf of a child that may be divided between the
6 parents in determining the amount of a child support obligation; and generally
7 relating to expenses considered in the determination of the amount of a child
8 support obligation.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Family Law**

17 12-204.

18 (i) By agreement of the parties or by order of court, the following expenses
19 incurred on behalf of a child may be divided between the parents in proportion to
20 their adjusted actual incomes:

21 (1) (I) any expenses for attending a special or private elementary or
22 secondary school to meet the particular educational needs of the child; [or] AND

23 (II) ANY EXPENSES FOR PRIVATE INSTRUCTION OR TUTORING TO
24 MEET THE PARTICULAR EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF THE CHILD; AND

25 (2) any expenses for transportation of the child between the homes of the
26 parents.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
2 October 1, 1998.
