By agreement of the parties or by order of court, the following expenses 18 19 incurred on behalf of a child may be divided between the parents in proportion to 20 their adjusted actual incomes: 21 any expenses for attending a special or private elementary or (1) 22 secondary school to meet the particular educational needs of the child; [or] AND ANY EXPENSES FOR PRIVATE INSTRUCTION OR TUTORING TO 23 (II)24 MEET THE PARTICULAR EDUCATIONAL NEEDS OF THE CHILD; AND
