A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - Dress Standards for Teachers and Other Professional Personnel**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the local boards of education to implement certain
4 guidelines for the clothing and other attire that may be worn by teachers and
5 other professional personnel during regularly scheduled school days in the
6 public schools in the county.

7 BY adding to
8 Article - Education
9 Section 6-113
10 Annotated Code of Maryland
11 (1997 Replacement Volume and 1997 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 6-113.

16 EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL IMPLEMENT WRITTEN GUIDELINES FOR THE
17 CLOTHING AND OTHER ATTIRE THAT MAY BE WORN BY ALL TEACHERS AND OTHER
18 PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL DURING REGULARLY SCHEDULED SCHOOL DAYS IN THE
19 PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 July 1, 1998.
