4 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date of the Chesapeake Bay
5 Commemorative License Plate Program until a certain date; and generally

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

2 13-618.

3 (c) (1) An original or substitute commemorative plate may only be issued
4 under this section for a fixed period of 2 consecutive years after its initial issuance.

5 (2) The Administration may only issue 1 commemorative plate under
6 this section at any one time.

**Chapter 3 of the Acts of the First Special Session of 1992, as amended by
8 Chapter 91 of the Acts of 1994 and Chapter 356 of the Acts of 1996**

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the
10 provisions of § 13-618(c) of the Transportation Article, the Motor Vehicle
11 Administration shall extend the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Plate Program
12 until July 1, [1998] 2000.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
14 effect June 1, 1998.
