- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 **Article - Insurance**
- 14 10-115.
- 15 (c) Before a certificate of qualification expires, the holder of the certificate of 16 qualification may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the holder:
- 17 otherwise is entitled to a certificate of qualification; (1)
- 18 files with the Commissioner a renewal application on the form that 19 the Commissioner provides;
- completes the continuing education requirements established under § 20
- 21 10-116 of this subtitle by [June 15 immediately prior to the expiration of the
- 22 certificate of qualification] THE JUNE 30 ON WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF
- 23 OUALIFICATION EXPIRES; and
- 24 pays to the Commissioner the renewal fee required by § 2-112 of this (4)
- 25 article.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 2 effect October 1, 1998.
