A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Insurance - Agents and Brokers - Continuing Education Requirements**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which an insurance agent or broker must
4 complete certain continuing education requirements; and generally relating to
5 continuing education for insurance agents and brokers.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Insurance**

14 10-115.

15 (c) Before a certificate of qualification expires, the holder of the certificate of
16 qualification may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the holder:

17 (1) otherwise is entitled to a certificate of qualification;

18 (2) files with the Commissioner a renewal application on the form that
19 the Commissioner provides;

20 (3) completes the continuing education requirements established under §
21 10-116 of this subtitle by [June 15 immediately prior to the expiration of the
22 certificate of qualification] THE JUNE 30 ON WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF
23 QUALIFICATION EXPIRES; and

24 (4) pays to the Commissioner the renewal fee required by § 2-112 of this
25 article.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect October 1, 1998.
