SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 (c) Before a certificate of qualification expires, the holder of the certificate of 16 qualification may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the holder:
17 (1) otherwise is entitled to a certificate of qualification;
18 (2) files with the Commissioner a renewal application on the form that 19 the Commissioner provides;

 2 10-116 of this subtitle by [June 15 immediately prior to the expiration of the
 3 certificate of qualification] THE JUNE 30 ON WHICH THE CERTIFICATE OF

- 5 (4) pays to the Commissioner the renewal fee required by § 2-112 of this 6 article.
