3 FOR the purpose of requiring certain professional employees to teach for a certain
4 amount of time in a classroom in a public or private school in the State for each

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 6-101.

15 (A) Unless [he] AN INDIVIDUAL is eligible to be issued a certificate by the
16 State Superintendent, [an] THE individual may not be employed as a county
17 superintendent, assistant superintendent, supervisor, principal, or teacher.

18 (B) FOR EACH RENEWAL OF A CERTIFICATE, A PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEE OF
19 A COUNTY BOARD, INCLUDING A COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT, ASSISTANT
20 SUPERINTENDENT, SUPERVISOR, PRINCIPAL, OR TEACHER SHALL, AT A MINIMUM,
21 TEACH FOR ONE FULL SEMESTER IN A CLASSROOM IN A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SCHOOL
22 IN THE STATE.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
24 July 1, 1998.
