A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Office for Children, Youth, and Families - State Coordinating Council**
3 **Designees**

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Superintendent of Schools to designate an
5 individual from the Division of Rehabilitation Services as a member of the State
6 Coordinating Council in the Office for Children, Youth, and Families; specifying
7 that each local coordinating council shall include a representative of the
8 Division; and generally relating to the membership of the State Coordinating
9 Council.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article 49D - Office for Children, Youth, and Families**

19 (a) The members of the Council are:

20 (1) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene or the Secretary's
21 designee;

22 (2) The Secretary of Human Resources or the Secretary's designee;

23 (3) The State Superintendent of Schools or the Superintendent's
24 [designee] DESIGNEE, INCLUDING A DESIGNEE FROM THE DIVISION OF
25 REHABILITATION SERVICES;

26 (4) The Director of the Governor's Office for Individuals with
27 Disabilities, as a nonvoting, ex officio member;

1 (5) The Special Secretary of the Office for Children, Youth, and Families
2 or the Special Secretary's designee; and

3 (6) The Secretary of the Department of Juvenile Justice or the
4 Secretary's designee.

6 Each local coordinating council shall include at least 1 representative from:

7 (1) The Mental Hygiene Administration;

8 (2) The Department of Juvenile Justice;

9 (3) The Developmental Disabilities Administration;

10 (4) The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration;

11 (5) The local board of education;

12 (6) The local health department;[and]

13 (7) The local department of social services; AND

14 (8) THE LOCAL OFFICE OF THE DIVISION OF REHABILITATION
15 SERVICES.

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 1998.
