5 FOR the purpose of ~~authorizing the State Superintendent of Schools to designate an~~
6 ~~individual from the Division of Rehabilitation Services as a member of the State~~

8 ~~that altering the membership of each local coordinating council shall include a~~
9 ~~representative of the Division~~ that is established by the State Coordinating
10 Council within the Office for Children, Youth, and Families for the provision of
11 services to children with disabilities; and generally relating to the membership
12 of the ~~State Coordinating Council~~ local coordinating councils that provide
13 services to children with disabilities within the Office of Children, Youth, and

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
