1 AN ACT concerning

2 University of Maryland School of Medicine - Admissions

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the University of Maryland School of Medicine to adopt
- 4 written admissions standards that include a Maryland county of residence as a
- 5 basis for considering certain applicants; requiring that applicants from counties
- of the State that were not represented in the previous year's admissions to the
- 7 School of Medicine be given additional consideration for admission; and
- 8 generally relating to admissions standards at the School of Medicine.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Education

- 17 15-101.
- 18 (a) Each public institution of higher education shall accept for admission any
- 19 graduate of an approved public high school:
- 20 (1) Who is certified by his high school principal, based on standards of
- 21 the State Board of Education, as qualified to pursue a course of study at the
- 22 institution; or
- 23 Who meets the admission standards of the institution.
- 24 (b) (1) Each public institution of higher education may accept, for special
- 25 admission any student who has:
- 26 (i) Completed the seventh grade; and

- 1 (ii) A scholastic aptitude test combined score of 1,200 or an 2 equivalent score on a nationally accepted college entrance examination.
- 3 (2) This subsection does not affect the State or local share of aid provided
- 4 pursuant to § 5-202 of the Education Article to the secondary school in which the
- 5 student is enrolled.
- 6 (C) THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SCHOOL OF MEDICINE SHALL DEVELOP 7 WRITTEN ADMISSIONS STANDARDS THAT INCLUDE:
- 8 (1) AN ADMISSIONS PROCESS THAT USES A MARYLAND COUNTY OF 9 RESIDENCE AS A BASIS FOR SELECTION OF SCHOOL OF MEDICINE STUDENTS; AND
- 10 (2) A REQUIREMENT THAT THE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE GIVE ADDITIONAL
- 11 CONSIDERATION TO AN APPLICANT FROM A PARTICULAR MARYLAND COUNTY IF NO
- 12 APPLICANT FROM THE COUNTY WAS ADMITTED TO THE SCHOOL IN THE PREVIOUS
- 13 YEAR.
- 14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 15 July 1, 1998.
