1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Private Passenger Motor Vehicle Insurance Policies - Coverage for Rental**  
3 **Cars**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain policies of private passenger motor vehicle  
5 insurance that include certain collision and comprehensive coverage to include  
6 coverage for certain rental cars under certain circumstances; and generally  
7 relating to private passenger motor vehicle insurance policies and coverage for  
8 rental cars.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article - Insurance**

2 19-512.

3 (b) (2) If a private passenger motor vehicle insurance policy issued, sold, or  
4 delivered in the State includes:

5 (I) collision coverage under this section ~~OR ANY COMPREHENSIVE~~  
6 ~~COVERAGE~~, the motor vehicles insured under that coverage shall include any  
7 passenger car that is rented by an insured for a period of 30 days or less under a  
8 rental agreement as otherwise defined in § 14-2101 of the Commercial Law Article;  
9 OR

10 (II) COMPREHENSIVE COVERAGE, THE MOTOR VEHICLES INSURED  
11 UNDER THAT COVERAGE SHALL INCLUDE ANY REPLACEMENT VEHICLE AS DEFINED  
12 UNDER § 18-102(A)(2)(I) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
14 effect October 1, 1998.
