3 FOR the purpose of extending application of the Maryland Automotive Warranty
4 Enforcement Act to motorcycles by altering the definition of a "motor vehicle" to
5 include a vehicle that is registered in this State as a Class D (motorcycle)
6 vehicle.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Commercial Law**

20 14-1501.

21 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

1 (c) (1) "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle that is registered in this State as a:

2 (i) Class A (passenger) vehicle;

3 (II) CLASS D (MOTORCYCLE) VEHICLE;

4 [(ii)] (III) Class E (truck) vehicle with a 3/4 ton or less
5 manufacturer's rated capacity; or

6 [(iii)] (IV) Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.

7 (2) "Motor vehicle" does not include a motor home. For the purpose of
8 administering this subtitle, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall promulgate a
9 regulation defining a motor home.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 1998.
