2 Baltimore County - School Buses - Seat Belts

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring a school bus in Baltimore County purchased after a
- 4 certain date by a noncollegiate educational institution or a local school board of
- 5 education, and used to transport children in Baltimore County, to be equipped
- 6 with certain seat belts or other appropriate restraining devices; requiring the
- 7 Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt regulations establishing standards for
- 8 seat belts or other appropriate restraining devices required under this Act;
- 9 requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to establish a program to equip
- in-use school buses in Baltimore County with seat belts or other appropriate
- 11 restraining devices within a certain period of time; prohibiting, after a certain
- date, the use of a school bus to transport children in Baltimore County if the
- school bus is not equipped with seat belts or other appropriate restraining
- devices; and generally relating to school bus equipment in Baltimore County.

- **HOUSE BILL 223** 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article - Education** 4 2-206. IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A SCHOOL BUS, AS DEFINED IN § 11-153 OF THE 5 (L) 6 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE, THAT A NONCOLLEGIATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION 7 PURCHASES ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1998, SHALL COMPLY WITH § 22-412.1 OF THE 8 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE. 9 7-805.1. 10 IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A SCHOOL BUS, AS DEFINED IN § 11-153 OF THE 11 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE, THAT THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION PURCHASES 12 ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 1998, SHALL COMPLY WITH § 22-412.1 OF THE TRANSPORTATION 13 ARTICLE. 14 **Article - Transportation** 15 11-153. 16 "School bus" means a Type I school vehicle, as defined in this subtitle. 17 11-173. 18 "Type I school vehicle" means a school vehicle that: (a) 19 (1) Is designed and constructed to carry passengers; 20 Is either of the body-on-chassis type construction or integral type (2) 21 construction; and 22 Has a gross vehicle weight of more than 10,000 pounds and provides 23 a minimum of 13 inches of seating space per passenger. "Type I school vehicle" does not include any bus operated by a common 24 25 carrier under the jurisdiction of a State, regional, or federal regulatory agency or 26 operated by the agency itself. 27 22-412.1.
- 28 (A) Every motor vehicle that is used by nursery schools, camps, day nurseries,
- 29 or day care centers for retarded children to transport children and that is not
- 30 regulated as a "school bus" under this article, shall be equipped with seat belts for
- 31 each seat and shall be subject to such other regulations as may be prescribed by the
- 32 Administration.

- 1 (B) (1) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, A SCHOOL BUS THAT IS PURCHASED ON OR 2 AFTER JULY 1, 1998, AND USED TO TRANSPORT CHILDREN SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH 3 SEAT BELTS OR OTHER APPROPRIATE RESTRAINING DEVICES FOR EACH SEAT.
- 4 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING 5 STANDARDS FOR SEAT BELTS AND RESTRAINING DEVICES REQUIRED UNDER THIS 6 SECTION.
- 7 (C) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROGRAM TO EQUIP 8 IN-USE SCHOOL BUSES IN BALTIMORE COUNTY PURCHASED BEFORE JULY 1, 1998 9 WITH SEAT BELTS OR OTHER APPROPRIATE RESTRAINING DEVICES IN ACCORDANCE 10 WITH THE ADMINISTRATION'S REGULAR SCHOOL BUS MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE.
- 11 (2) AFTER JULY 1, 2003, A SCHOOL BUS MAY NOT BE USED TO
 12 TRANSPORT CHILDREN IN BALTIMORE COUNTY UNLESS THE SCHOOL BUS IS
 13 EQUIPPED WITH SEAT BELTS OR OTHER APPROPRIATE RESTRAINING DEVICES FOR
 14 EACH SEAT.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 July 1, 1998.
