12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Public Utility Companies**

15 5-304.

16 (a) (1) A public service company shall notify the Commission of any accident
17 involving the public service company that results in:

18 (I) personal injury[,] REQUIRING HOSPITALIZATION;

19 (II) property damage[,] EXCEEDING \$50,000; or

1 (III) loss of life.

2 (2) The public service company shall notify the Commission within 30
3 days after the day the accident occurs or within a period that the Commission
4 prescribes.

5 (b) The notice:

6 (1) shall be in a form that the Commission prescribes; and

7 (2) may not be admissible in evidence, or used for any purpose against
8 the public service company that provides the notice, in an action for damages arising
9 out of any matter that is reported in the notice.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 1998.
