11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 15 (a) The Commission shall appoint a General Counsel.
- 16 (b) The General Counsel shall have been admitted to practice law in the State.

17 (c) [Before taking office, the General Counsel shall take the oath required by 18 Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.

19 (d)] The General Counsel serves at the pleasure of the Commission.

[(e)] (D) As the Commission directs, the General Counsel shall:
(1) represent the Commission in a proceeding if the Commission is a
party to or desires to intervene in the proceeding, if the proceeding involves a
question under this article, or if the proceeding involves an act or order of the
Commission;
(2) advise the Commission, on request, on any legal question that
requires interpretation of a provision of law about the jurisdiction, rights, duties, or
powers of the Commission; and
