11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Public Utility Companies**

14 2-106.

15 (a) The Commission shall appoint a General Counsel.

16 (b) The General Counsel shall have been admitted to practice law in the State.

17 (c) [Before taking office, the General Counsel shall take the oath required by
18 Article I, § 9 of the Maryland Constitution.

19 (d)] The General Counsel serves at the pleasure of the Commission.

1 [(e)] (D) As the Commission directs, the General Counsel shall:

2 (1) represent the Commission in a proceeding if the Commission is a
3 party to or desires to intervene in the proceeding, if the proceeding involves a
4 question under this article, or if the proceeding involves an act or order of the
5 Commission;

6 (2) advise the Commission, on request, on any legal question that
7 requires interpretation of a provision of law about the jurisdiction, rights, duties, or
8 powers of the Commission; and

9 (3) act as attorney to the Commission as the Commission reasonably
10 requires.

11 [(f)] (E) The Commission may substitute any other agent for the General
12 Counsel.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 1998.
