- 2 Creation of a State Debt Anne Arundel County Brooklyn Park Middle 3 School
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 5 \$2,200,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the County Executive and
- 6 County Council of Anne Arundel County for certain acquisition, development, or
- 7 improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; and
- 8 providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 10 MARYLAND, That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Anne Arundel
- 13 County Brooklyn Park Middle School Loan of 1998 in the total principal amount of
- 14 \$2,200,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 15 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 16 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 17 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 18 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 19 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 20 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 21 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 22 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 23 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 24 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 25 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 26 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the County Executive and County Council
- 27 of Anne Arundel County for the planning, design, repair, renovation, reconstruction,
- 28 construction, and capital equipping of Brooklyn Park Middle School, to provide for
- 29 shared use of the facility by community organizations for programs that benefit the

- 1 community, including such programs as Take Back Our Streets, DARE, and outreach 2 in the North County area by the Maryland Hall for the Creative Arts.
- 3 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 4 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 5 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 6 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 June 1, 1998.
